### KAAF Art Prize 2016

The Korea-Australia Arts Foundation prize (KAAFP) is conducted annually in cooperation with the Korean Cultural Centre (KCC), run by the Korean government. Selected artworks will be exhibited at the KCC in Sydney.

The KAAFP for 2016 will be open themed and medium of 2D artworks. The KAAF 2016 art prize has a non-acquisitive cash prize of total value \$14,000 for the artists.

In addition KAAF seeks to endeavour its support for the Australian multicultural society and take part in promoting philosophy of a truly cultural and ecological community.

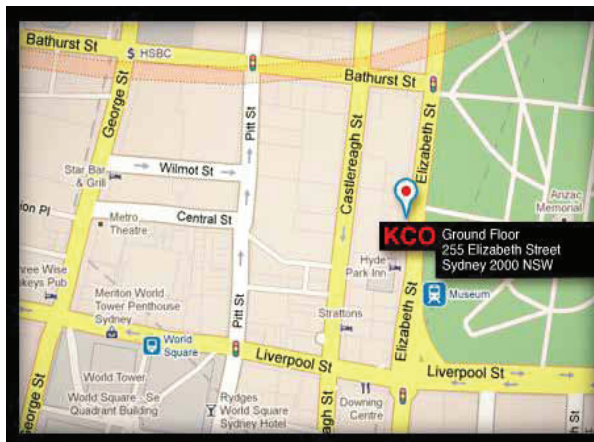

## Conditions of Entry

The prize is open to all Australian citizens or Australian permanent residents of at least 12 months.

Candidates must be 18 years or older to be eligible.

The KAAF Art Prize 2016 is of open theme and medium and only 2D artworks will be accepted.

### Entry Fee

There is a non-refundable fee of \$40 for single entry and \$70 for 2 entries. Entries without this fee will be ineligible.

Payments made by cheque must be made payable to: Korea-Australia Arts Foundation. Any direct deposits must be made to KAAF 032069-439691 (Westpac). Artists must state their name in the reference/message field. Receipts will be emailed upon request.

### Entry Requirements

All entries (digital image) must be accompanied by a completed entry form, fee, payment receipt screen shot (if via online) and CV. Artists must submit a Curriculum Vitae (**maximum one page**) detailing the artist's professional work and exhibition history. Submissions must be of works executed no earlier than January 2015. Slides, photographs, photocopied reproductions or any other representation of works dated previously will not be accepted.

A maximum of **two** digital images can be entered via email or on CD to postal Address of Korea-Australia Arts Foundation:  
24 Darlington Drive Cherrybrook NSW 2126.

Digital images should be no larger than 2.5MB, saved in JPEG format. Files must be able to be opened on a standard PC.

JPEG images that are saved on CD should adhere to the following naming convention: Title - First name Surname.

A print ready digital image will be used for promotional purposes for the KCC in the future.

Works may not exceed 1.3 metres in any given dimension (including frame). Multiple parts are acceptable, but must not exceed overall size limits.

All works selected must be sent with hanging fixtures attached and must be marked clearly on the back with the artist's name, address and title of work. If required, special hanging fittings and fixtures must be supplied with clear instructions.

It is intended that the works selected by the judges will be shown in an exhibition at the KCC: 255 Elizabeth Street, Sydney NSW 2000.

The KAAF and KCC will not be responsible for any loss or

damage suffered to any painting whilst in its possession or under its control. Paintings will not be insured by the KAAF or KCC.

The KCC will not be responsible for the sale of works.

All entries selected for exhibition must be available for continuous display at the KCC for the entire period of the exhibition. Artists and/or representatives may not remove any artwork from display prior to 27th January 2017

Artists selected for exhibition will allow their works to be reproduced in print and electronic formats for the purpose of advertising and promoting the prize and the exhibition.

The KAAF reserves the right to reproduce the winning entry in relation to the prize.

All personal information gathered by the KAAF will be used solely for the purpose of administering the KAAF Arts Foundation Prize.

Artists will not be notified of the selection results before 12th November 2016.

The selected artworks/artists will be announced on our website ([www.kaaf.org.au](http://www.kaaf.org.au)) no later than 13th November 2016.

The entering artwork must not have been selected for show elsewhere previously.

### Return of works

After the close of exhibition on 27.01.2017, artists may collect their works over 2 days from 30th - 31st January 2017 between 11am-5pm from the KCC. Artists or their representatives must present ID upon collection of their works. Uncollected artworks will NOT be held unless other arrangements are made prior to those dates. All artists will be responsible for the transport of their work and its cost to and from the Korean Cultural Centre.

### Sale of Artworks

Selected artists are invited to price their works for sale. The KAAF takes 30% commission.
